- Improve the percentage of students reaching Regional PM Benchmark to 80% or greater.
- Improve the percentage of students reaching a C or greater to 80% in English.
- Provide increased support for students requiring intensive speech language programs across the school.

Our initiatives include

- Targeted intervention and extension for students in reading, writing and speech language development.
- Employment of a Speech Pathologist in addition to the region allocation to provide targeted intervention, develop speech language programs, complete assessments and provide specific teaching strategies for teachers to implement.
- Continue to promote reading at home by providing students with an online reading program that allows them to have access to multiple books targeted at their level.
